Topic Focus: Our Father Table Talk Discussion Questions



Main Point:

The words "Our Father" give us identity, freedom to approach God, and assurance that He hears and will answer our prayers.

Table Talk Discussion:

Through the week create meaningful conversation. Adjust questions as needed, and may God bless this faith conversation in your home.

Look up Matthew 6:9-13 and read through the Lord's Prayer together.

- 1. When are you most likely to pray in your normal, day-to-day life?
- 2. When you think of the Lord's Prayer, do you tend to think of it more as an exciting gift that Jesus has given you, or more like a boring ritual you learned in Church/Sunday School?
- 3. If the prayer feels more like a ritual to you, what do you think it would take to reclaim its beauty and power in your life?
- 4. How does God's invitation to call Him Father impact your Christian life?
- 5. Do you believe there are people who shouldn't pray "Our Father"? Are there people on the outside who aren't included? Think locally (bullies at your school, mean friends, etc.) and globally (terrorists, atheists, etc.).
- 6. When we pray the Lord's Prayer we begin with the words "Our Father who art in heaven." What do these words have to say about the confidence we have in coming to God with our needs?

Close:

End your time in prayer- whether prayer requests, or just a general prayer thanking God for the ways we can know truths about Him and about ourselves.
